## ~:ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE SCHOOL IN BRIEF:~

The results of the board classes have been excellent since the beginning. In the session 2019-20, **379** students appeared in AISSE and **90** students secured **90%** and above marks with **100%** results. In AISSCE (Science) **248** Students appeared and **96** students secured **90%** and above marks. In AISSCE (Commerce) **19** students out of **98** scored **90%** and above marks. In AISSCE Science and Commerce the results were **100%**.

A large number of students competed in various competitive exams. 24 students for JEE-MAINS and 6 students qualified for Medical.

Our students also prove their mettle in co-curricular activities in sports in District, Cluster, Zonal and state level as well as DAV National Sports. Students participate in Kho-kho, Athletics, Yoga, Chess, Judo, Gymnastics, Hockey, Badminton, Table Tennis, Karate, etc.

**~:UTMOST CARE NEEDED:~**

Parents are urged to take utmost and wholesome care of their wards' studies and well-being. Parents ought to make their ward attend all classes and do homework in their copies, subject-wise. If students remained absent for some days, teacher should contact the parents through students' diaries and vice versa. Teachers will check the copies.

**~:STUDENT'S DIARY:~**

Please use the student's diary as a means of communication with the school by checking the remarks, if any made by the teachers. It contains the following:

- ❖ A holiday calendar at the end of it.
- ❖ A section for the communication between the school and parents, leave/absent record of the student.
- ❖ Details with regard to fee, uniform, 75% attendance etc.
- ❖ Diaries will be supplied from school.

**~:SPOKEN ENGLISH:~**

Please encourage your wards to speak in English. If possible, you should speak to them in English.

### **~:SCHOOL UNIFORM:~**

Please go through the student's diary for necessary details about the uniform and ensure that your wards come to school in proper uniform and get up. Boys and girls must have pants/skirts /shirts of proper length and height. Uniforms are available in the market. On Wednesday and Saturday: White uniform.

### **~:HAIR AND SHOES:~**

School recommends well-trimmed hair for boys and well tied hair for girls with black or white hair band/grip and formal brown shoes (Oxford Style) & prescribed brown socks. Wide toed or long pointed shoes are in no case permitted in the school campus. Girls are not allowed to use any type of lipstick and ornaments.

### **~:CELL PHONE:~**

Students are strictly forbidden to bring cell phones or any electronic gadgets to school. If caught, their cell will be confiscated and a fine of Rs. 1000/- will be imposed.

### **~:MOTOR BIKE STRICTLY PROHIBITED:~**

Students are strictly prohibited to bring a motorbike in the school campus or around one K.M. from the school. If caught, strict action will be taken against them and they will be removed from the school.

Please send your wards to school in time so that they may attend the morning assembly compulsorily every day. Please ensure that they may not be late to the morning assembly.
