1. A, B and C are partners with fixed capitals of 1,00,000, 2,00,000 and 3,00,000 respectively. Their partnership deed provides that : (a) A is to be allowed a monthly salary of 600 and B is to be allowed a monthly salary of 400. (b) C will be allowed a commission of 5% of the net profit after allowing salaries of A and B. (c) Interest is to be allowed on capitals @ 6%. (d) Interest will be charged on partners annual drawings at 4%. (e) The annual drawings were : B 10,000 and C 15,000. The net profit for the year ending 31st march, 2014 amounted to 1,72,000. Prepare P&L Appropriation account.
2. David and John were partners in a firm sharing profits in the ratio of 4 : 1. Their capitals on 1.4.2006 were : David Rs.2,50,000 and John Rs.50,000. The partnership deed provided that David will get a commission of 10% on the net profit after allowing a salary of Rs.2,500 per month to John. The profit of the firm for the year ended 31.3.2007 was Rs.1,40,000. Prepare Profit and Loss Appropriation Account for the year ended 31.3.2007
3. A, B and C were partners in a firm having capitals of Rs.60,000, Rs.60,000 and Rs.80,000 respectively. Their current account balances were : A Rs.10,000; B Rs.5,000 and C Rs.2,000 (Dr.). According to the partnership deed the partners were entitled to interest on capital @5% p.a. C being the working partner was also entitled to a salary of Rs.6,000 p.a. The profits were to be divided as follows: (a) The first Rs.20,000 in proportion to their capitals (b) Next Rs.30,000 in the ratio of 5 : 3 : 2 (c) Remaining profits to be shared equally The firm made a profit of Rs.1,56,000 before charging any of the above items. Prepare the profit and loss appropriation account and pass the necessary Journal entry for the appropriation of profits.
4. Calculate interest on A's drawing : (1) If he has withdrawn 60,000 on 1st oct. 2006 and the rate of interest on drawing is 8% per annum. (2) If he has withdrawn 60,000 on 1st oct. 2006 and the rate of interest on drawing is 8%. Books are closed on 31st march 2007
5. A and B were partners in a firm sharing profits and losses in the ratio 3:2. They admitted C as a new partner for 3/7th share in the profit and the new profit sharing ratio will be 2:2:3. C brought Rs 2,00,000 as his capital and Rs 1,50,000 as a premium of goodwill. half of their share of premium was withdrawn by A and B from the firm. Calculate the sacrificing ratio and pass necessary journal entries for the above transactions in the book of the firm
6. A, B and C are partners in a firm. On 1-4-2010 their capital stood at 50,000 25,000 25,000 respectively. As per provisions of the partnership deed : (a) C was entitled for a salary of 1,000 p.m. (b) Partners were entitled to interest on capital at 5% p.a. (c) Profits were to be shared in the ratio of capital. The net profit for the year ended 2011 of 33,000 was divided equally without providing for the above terms
7. A, B and C are partners in a firm. On 1-4-2010 their capital stood at 50,000 25,000 25,000 respectively. As per provisions of the partnership deed : (a) C was entitled for a salary of 1,000 p.m. (b) Partners were entitled to interest on capital at 5% p.a. (c) Profits were to be shared in the ratio of capital. The net profit for the year ended 2011 of 33,000 was divided equally without providing for the above terms
8. Anna and Bobby were partners sharing profits and losses in the ratio of 5 : 3. On 1st April, 2014 their capital accounts showed balances of ₹ 3,00,000 and ₹ 2,00,000 respectively. Calculate the amount of profit to be distributed between the partners if the partnership deed provided for interest on capital @ 10% per annum and the firm earned a profit of ₹ 45,000 for the year ended 31st March, 2015.
9. On 1st April, 2013, Brij and Nandan entered into partnership to construct toilets in government girls schools in the remote areas of Uttarakhand. They contributed capitals of ₹ 10,00,000 and ₹ 15,00,000 respectively. Their profit sharing ratio was 2 : 3 and interest allowed on capital as provided in the partnership deed was 12% per annum. During the year ended 31st March, 2014, the firm earned a profit of ₹ 2,00,000. Prepare profit and loss appropriation account of Brij and Nandan for the year ended 31st March, 2014

10. Sonu and Rajat started a partnership firm on 1st April, 2017. They contributed ₹ 8,00,000 and ₹ 6,00,000 respectively as their capitals and decided to share profits and losses in the ratio of 3 : 2. The partnership deed provided that Sonu was to be paid a salary of ₹ 20,000 per month and Rajat a commission of 5% on turnover. It also provided that interest on capital be allowed @ 8% p.a. Sonu withdrew ₹ 20,000 on 1st December, 2017 and Rajat withdrew ₹ 5,000 at the end of each month. Interest on drawings was charged @ 6% p.a. The net profit as per Profit and Loss Account for the year ended 31st March, 2018 was ₹ 1,89,950. The turnover of the firm for the year ended 31st March, 2018 amounted to ₹ 20,00,000. Pass necessary journal entries for the above transactions in the books of Sonu and Rajat.
11. P and Q were partners in a firm sharing profits in the ratio of 5 : 3. On 1st April, 2014 they admitted R as a new partner for 1/8th share in the profits with a guaranteed profit of ₹ 75,000. The new profit sharing ratio between P and Q will remain the same but they agreed to bear any deficiency on account of guarantee to R in the ratio of 3 : 2. The profit of the firm for the year ended 31st March, 2015 was ₹ 4,00,000. Prepare profit and loss appropriation account of P, Q and R for the year ended 31st March, 2015.
12. A, B and C were partners in a firm. On 1st April, 2008, their fixed capitals stood at ₹ 50,000, ₹ 25,000 and ₹ 25,000 respectively.
As per the provisions of the partnership deed
(i) B was entitled for a salary of ₹ 5,000 per annum.
(ii) All the partners were entitled to interest on capital at 5% per annum.
(iii) Profits were to be shared in the ratio of capitals.
The net profit for the year ending 31st March, 2009 of ₹ 33,000 and 31st March, 2010 of ₹ 45,000 was divided equally without providing for the above terms.
Pass an adjustment journal entry to rectify the above error.
13. A, B and C were partners. Their capitals were ₹ 30,000, ₹ 20,000 and ₹ 10,000 respectively. According to the partnership deed, they were entitled to interest on capital @ 5% per annum. In addition, B was also entitled to draw a salary of ₹ 500 per month. C was entitled to a commission of 5% on the profits after charging the interest on capitals but before charging the salary payable to B. The net profits for the year were ₹ 30,000 distributed in the ratio of their capitals without providing for any of the above adjustments. The profits were to be shared in the ratio of 2 : 2 : 1.
Pass the necessary adjustment entry showing the working clearly.
14. Hari, Kunal and Uma are partners in a firm sharing profits and losses in the ratio of 5 : 3 : 2. From 1st April, 2018 they decided to share future profits and losses in the ratio of 2 : 5 : 3. Their Balance Sheet showed a balance of ₹ 75,000 in the Profit and Loss Account and a balance of ₹ 15,000 in Investment Fluctuation Fund. For this purpose, it was agreed that:
(i) Goodwill of the firm was valued at ₹ 3,00,000.
(ii) Investments (having a book value of ₹ 50,000) were valued at ₹ 35,000.
(iii) Stock having a book value of ₹ 50,000 be depreciated by 10%.
Pass the necessary journal entries for the above in the books of the firm
15. Satish and Taruna were partners in a firm sharing profits and losses in the ratio of 3 : 2. From 1st April, 2018 they decided to share profits equally. On that date, their Balance Sheet showed a credit balance of ₹ 35,000 in workmen compensation fund and ₹ 40,000 in general reserve. The goodwill of the firm on that date was valued at ₹ 50,000. The firm accepted a claim of ₹ 40,000 for workmen compensation.
Pass necessary journal entries for the above transactions on the reconstitution of the firm.
16. Radhika, Bani and Chitra were partners in a firm sharing profits and losses in the ratio of 2 : 3 : 1. With effect from 1st April, 2018 they decided to share future profits and losses in the ratio of 3 : 2 : 1. On that date their Balance Sheet showed a debit balance of ₹ 24,000 in Profit and Loss Account and a balance of ₹ 1,44,000 in general reserve. It was also agreed that:
(a) The goodwill of the firm be valued at ₹ 1,80,000.
(b) The land (having book value of ₹ 3,00,000) will be valued at ₹ 4,80,000.
Pass the necessary journal entries for the above changes.

17. X, Y and Z are partners sharing profits and losses in the ratio of 5 : 4 : 1. Calculate sacrificing or gaining share for each if Z acquires 1/10th share of X and 1/2 share of Y.
